Any entered team may bring as many "Open Runners" as they would like to run the Brian Pickl Mile. This event will not be scored. High Jump: The Boys will jump first, and then the girls will follow after a warm-up period.
Women's Opening Height will be 4' 4"
(Raises will be as follows...4' $7^{\prime \prime}, 4^{\prime} 9^{\prime \prime}, 4^{\prime} 11^{\prime \prime}$ and then $1^{\prime \prime}$ until the end)
Men's Opening Height will be 5' 2 "
(Raises will be as follows...5' $5^{\prime \prime}, 5^{\prime} 7^{\prime \prime}, 5^{\prime} 9^{\prime \prime}$ and then $1^{\prime \prime}$ until the end)

Pole Vault: Due to the time constraints of the Pole Vault, each competitor will be limited to 7 total attempts (even makes). Three consecutive misses still results in elimination from the competition. Competitors are encouraged to think about what heights he or she will attempt beforehand. Girls will vault first, then the boys will follow after a warm-up period.

Men's Opening Height will be $8^{\prime} 0$ " ( $1^{\text {st }}$ Raise to $9^{\prime} 0^{\prime \prime}$ and then raises $6^{\prime \prime}$ at a time)
Women's Opening Height will be 6 ' 0 " (1st Raise to 7 " 0 " and then raises 6 " at a time)

## Relay zone colors

$4 \times 100$ is Gold

$4 \times 200$ is Green-Green-Gold
$4 \times 400$ is Black $4 \times 800$ is Black
$4 \times 100 \& 4 \times 200$ exchange zones are 30 meters and do not have acceleration marks.

## Staggers for races

4 X 200 M Relay
.Girl-Boy-Girl-Boy
4 turn stagger (lanes all the way). White with Green Line Start
Exchange Zone 1 is Green, Exchange Zone 2 is Green, and Exchange Zone 3 is Gold
$4 \times 1600$ M Relay
Boy-Girl-Boy-Girl
1 turn double waterfall start will be used with teams in each alley divided by a green dash inside lane 5
All exchanges will be black triangles divided by the start finish line
Sprint Medley .............................................Girl-Boy-Girl-Boy
(400-200-200-400)
The first 3 legs will comprise a 4 turn stagger and run in lanes all the way.
The final 400 meter leg will be permitted to cut into lane one when a clear path to lane 1 is open.
There is no acceleration zone for \#4 runner
Exchange Zone 1 is Green, Exchange Zone 2 is Gold, and Exchange Zone 3 is Black

## 4 X 800 M Relay

Boy-Girl-Boy-Girl
1 turn double waterfall start will be used with teams in each alley divided by a green dash inside lane 5
All exchanges will be black triangles divided by the start finish line
Shuttle Hurdle Relay ** $\qquad$ Boy-Girl-Boy-Girl
We will run up to 3 teams at a time using lanes $1 \& 2,4 \& 5,7 \& 8$ with a lane in between each.
Male runners will run to the North (opposite of normal) while girls will run in a normal direction.

## Shot/Discus $4 \times 200$ M Relay

.Boy-Girl-Boy-Girl (Shot \& Discus Entries Only)
4 turn stagger (lanes all the way). White with Green Line Start
Exchange Zone 1 is Green, Exchange Zone 2 is Green, and Exchange Zone 3 is Gold
Distance Medley Relay
.Girl-Boy-Girl-Boy
(1200-400-800-1600)
1 turn double waterfall start will be used with teams in each alley divided by a green dash inside lane 5
All exchanges will be black triangles divided by the start finish line
4 X 100 M Relay
Boy-Girl-Boy-Girl
2 turn stagger (lanes all the way). White with White start line
Gold exchange zones all the way, exchange zones are 30 meters and do not have acceleration marks.
$4 \times 400$ M Relay $\qquad$ Girl-Boy-Girl-Boy
3 turn stagger (lanes all the way). White with Black Line Start
First runner lanes all the way passing in the staggered black triangles
Second runner cuts in after passing the green and white dashed line as you enter the back stretch
